

## Museum of Fire COVID Safe Plan for School Groups

The Museum of Fire is a COVID Safe organisation and as such we endeavour to conduct all school groups in a COVID safe manner.



## Action being undertaken by the Museum to reduce the risk to staff, volunteers and visitors

- Regular and increased cleaning and disinfecting of all surfaces in accordance with Safe Work Australia guidelines and the Public Health Authority.
- To ensure NSW Government guidelines are followed, the number of visitors in certain areas inside and outside of the Museum space will be limited, including (but not restricted to):
  - o Maximum 20 people in a group outside.
  - o Maximum 20 people per school group booking (excluding staff).
  - Maximum 12 people in the Junior Firefighter Zone.
- To ensure social distancing is adhered to:
  - Travel around the exhibition space and entry areas will be in one direction only. This will be directed by markings on the floor.
- Program activities will be modified to conform to COVID Safe guidelines:
  - o Dress-ups will be removed from the fire engine activity held in the theatre.
  - The model fire engine will be cleaned down after each use.
  - At this stage there will be no fire engine rides.
- At all times, the educator must ensure personal social distancing is carried out.
- Teacher's are responsible for enforcing any of your schools COVID Safe policies whilst off site.

## **Information for Teachers**

- Teachers must ensure social distancing is in place between students as stipulated by school policy.
- Teachers will need to provide contact tracing information at the time of booking.
- School groups will need to adhere to the movement policy and follow the arrows on the floor.
